Pledge of Allegiance

Attendance: Supervisor Brent Sweet, Councilman Ron Thomson, Councilman John Stine and Councilman Mike Fayette, Attorney Bob Slye and Jessy Hudson, Town Clerk.

Approval of minutes: Motion to approve June 10 & 17 minutes. Motion made by Councilman Mike Fayette seconded by Councilman John Stine. Ayes 4 Nays 0 Absent 1 (Caputo).

Approval of Bills: Motion made by Supervisor Brent Sweet seconded by Councilman Ron Thomson to approve the bills.

Open Bids for property on Route 12(Near Lindon Cove entrance): One bid submitted: Mr. & Mrs. Ronald Randell submitted a bid for the amount of \$3362.00. Motion made by Councilman Ron Thomson to accept the bid price of \$3362.00 seconded by Councilman John Stine. Ayes 4 Nays 0 Absent 1 (Caputo). Motion Passed.

Hire a part-time laborer for Transfer Site: Motion by Councilman Ron Thomson to hire Jake Hanvy as a part-time laborer at the rate of \$15.00 per hour seconded by Councilman Mike Fayette. Ayes 4 Nays 0 Absent 1(Caputo). Motion Passed.

Update on Butterfield Lake Dock Issues: Issues with floatation & tubes are being worked on. Supervisor Sweet will keep the board updated on the progress of the docks.

Goose Bay Parking Lot: Boat trailers are being left in the parking lot for several days. The board discussed several options that could help with the problem. One of the options was to put a ticket on their trailer or vehicle letting them know there over the 48 hrs. Signs are up on the property letting people know about the 48 hour parking only. Board asked Attorney Slye if it would be in the towns best interest to do a Local Law that monitors, tows vehicles and sets fines. Attorney Slye will look into the Law.

Privilege of the floor: Wanda Lopez, Wellesley Island asked the board to consider lowering her property assessment because the water is not drinkable. Lopez told the board that for 10 years she has been unable to drink the water and feels that her assessment should be lowered by half because of it. Supervisor Sweet let her know that she should contact the assessor to fill out the paperwork to grieve her assessment.

Joseph Masszaros, Wellesley Island asked the board to lower his assessment because of not being able to drink his water. Supervisor let him know to contact assessor and follow the grievance procedures.

2nd Q: Why the town does not accept batteries anymore? Supervisor Sweet let him know that the company that was picking the batteries up no longer have that service. 3rd Q: Is the town still buying the Bonnie Castle Rec Center? Supervisor let him know that there are conditions that have to be met before the town moves forward.




